Saturday, March 22, 2025 12pm-3pm, **CONSERVATION PROJECT:** Help UI Conservation Biology Club members identify native plants and weeds. Meet at the native planting on the walkway on UI campus on the north side of the Guy Wicks soccer fields (directly south of Tri-State but across the highway and Paradise Creek, then west on the paved pathway.
